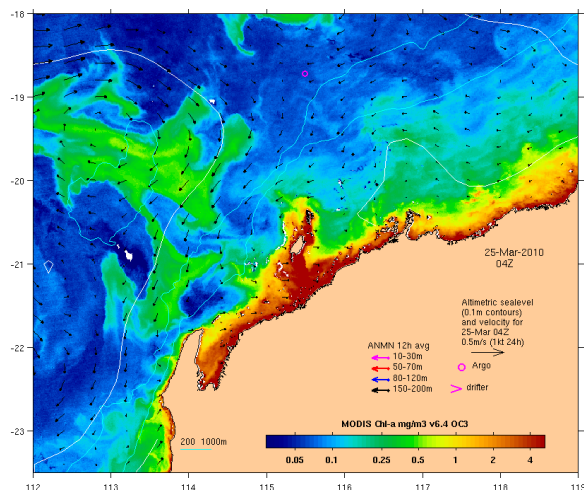

### IMOS OceanCurrent

This section highlights news from the IMOS *OceanCurrent* website in the past month <http://oceancurrent.imos.org.au/>

NASA's Aqua satellite, carrying the MODIS instrument, was launched on 4 May 2002.

The IMOS SRS recently completed a re-processing of the entire dataset from 2002-2012, and this is now available on the [OceanCurrent](#) website along with the re-processed altimetric estimates of ocean surface velocity (and other data) for individual regions around Australia.



The best images of the whole 2002-2012 period for the Perth region are listed and briefly discussed in the [29 May News item](#).

One researcher who is very grateful for this new archive of publication-ready graphics is Prof Anya Waite of UWA, who needed a MODIS [image](#) for her paper, to convince a reviewer of her *Biogeosciences Journal* article that the *Trichodesmium* bloom transected by RV Southern Surveyor really was as large (100kmx100km near 19.8S, 113.5E) as they claimed.
