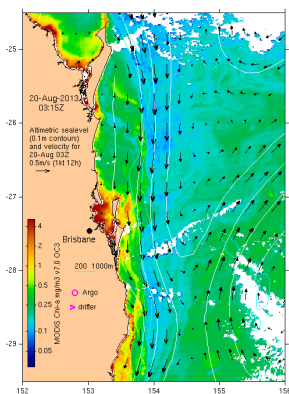

### 23 August 2013: MODIS imagery updating in real time

Now that issues at the National Computational Infrastructure (NCI) have been resolved, IMOS SRS has resumed production of MODIS chlorophyll-a imagery. The processing system has been updated to SeaDAS7.0, which includes the latest calibration, so the chlorophyll estimates are quite different to the SeaDAS6.0 estimates produced earlier.

## New Data Streams

New data streams publicly available via the [IMOS Ocean Portal](#) since the previous edition of the IMOS Bulletin.

Comment from the IMOS Director: Availability of new data will be slower than normal for a little while, as I have asked the eMII team to focus on getting all IMOS data into a new database and improving functionality of the Ocean Portal in line with user feedback. If this raises any concerns in the interim, please contact the IMOS Office to discuss.

**ABOS:** The first datasets from the ITF deepwater array have been processed and are now available via the Ocean Portal.

**AUV:** Many new campaigns have been uploaded recently and data is currently being processed to be incorporated into the AUV viewer.
