Primary Font

Helvetica Neue - light

Typeface rules

Helvetica Neue - light is used for body copy in print. Regular is used to highlight where appropriate. **Bold** or **condesned black** can be used, however only when absolutely necessary and very sparingly within doccuments.



Secondary fonts are to only be used when Helvetica Neue is unavailable.







IMOS Logo Use

The IMOS logo includes a stacked and wide alternative and should be used according to the size and structure. Only these 2 logo variants are to be used and the "waves and IMOS" graphic component are **never to be used** without the supporting "Integrated Marine Observing System" text. The colour logo is the preferred logo to be used on documents and presentation material, however the mono version is to be used when overlayed upon coloured backgrounds that cause illegibility of the logo in its entirety.





